RESOLUTION #5

WHEREAS: there is immediate and pressing need for the provision of properly regulated off-street parking areas for student and faculty automobiles; and

WHEREAS: this need is increased by the construction program presently in progress on the campus; and

WHEREAS: the City of Bremerton has declared itself willing to cooperate in ameliorating this problem by improving and leasing to the college city-owned property adjacent to the campus and surrounding Roosevelt Field on two sides for operation during day-class hours of the regular school year; and

WHEREAS: it will be necessary to levy and collect parking fees to defray costs of leasing the Roosevelt Field parking lot, employ necessary attendants for the supervision of all parking lots operated, and maintain and improve college parking facilities.

BE IT THEREBY RESOLVED: It shall be the policy of Olympic College to establish, maintain, and operate designated, regulated off-street parking facilities for student and faculty vehicles as a self-sustaining auxiliary service enterprise. Students and staff members desiring to avail themselves of parking privileges at college operated parking lots shall register their vehicles with the Office of Student Affairs, abide by the regulations set forth by the college administration, and pay the following quarterly fees during the regular school year:

Five Dollars (\$5.00) per quarter if a student
Six Dollars (\$6.00) per quarter if a classified employee
of the college
Seven Dollars (\$7.00) per quarter if a certified employee
of the college

The President of the College is authorized to rent, lease,
and contract for the use of properties adjacent to or near the
campus of Olympic College for use as vehicle parking lots for
faculty and students when feasible and necessary.

WHEREAS this action is deemed necessary for the welfare of the employees
and students of the college and the public, the provisions of
this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its
adoption.
