RESOLUTION NO. 9

WHEREAS: Denatured alcohol is regularly used for instruction purposes in connection with the science instruction programs at Olympic College, and


WHEREAS: Purchase and utilization of this commodity on a tax-free basis for instructional purposes is regulated by the United States Treasury Department, and

WHEREAS: Authority to requisition the purchase of, receive, and maintain constant inventory control, render applications and reports to the U. S. Treasury Department, and otherwise supervise the storage and distribution of this commodity for the college should be invested in one person,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Walter H. Kembel, of the Olympic College staff be authorized to sign applications, reports and other documents to comply with requirements of the United States Treasury Department in connection with the use of tax-free alcohol for instructional purposes in all units of Olympic College.

That such authority be granted retroactive to March 1, 1968.
