RESOLUTION NO. 27

WHEREAS, the State Board for Community College Education has since 1967

sought alternate fund sources to provide for construction to meet the continued growth of Community Colleges, and

WHEREAS, the sole source of Community College capital funds and bonds repaid from student tuition are inadequate to keep pace with the building needs of the system for the foreseeable future, and

WHEREAS, Referendum 31 would provide for \$50,000,000 in general obligation bonds to be repaid from the State General Fund, rather than local property taxes or student tuition without the need for additional increased taxes, and

WHEREAS, \$50,000,000 would provide funds to meet the most critical building needs of the Community College System in the 1970's, and

WHEREAS, Community College District No. 3 will benefit from the passage of Referendum 31 by providing funds for a learning resources building addition and a new facility for the health occupations,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 3 solidly endorses Referendum 31 as a necessary supplement to the capital funds requirements of the Community College System which will help to provide space for instructional programs in this State.
